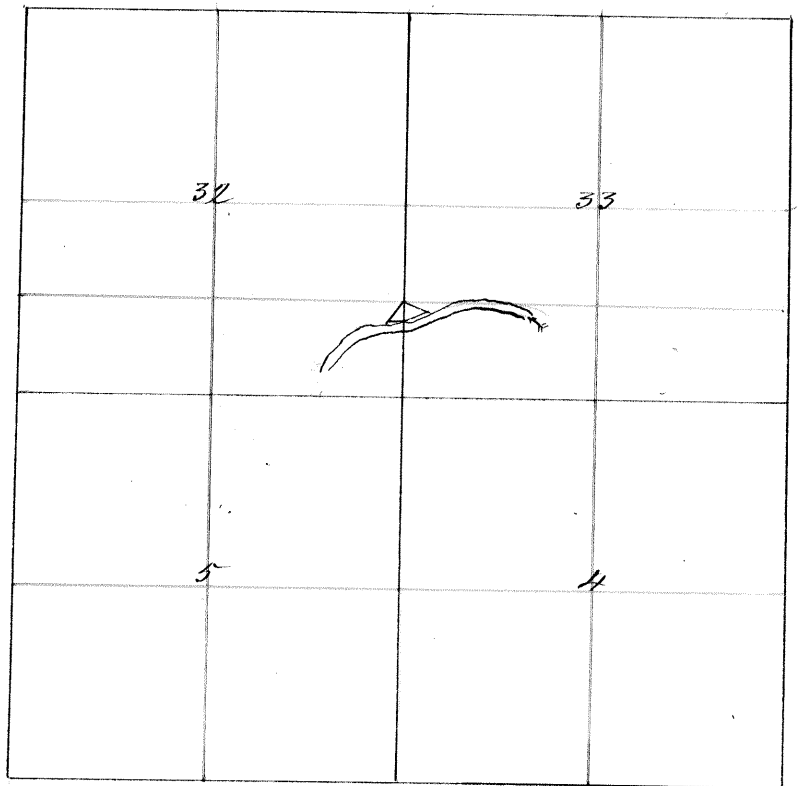

thence $N 71\frac{3}{4}^{\circ} W$ 7.12 chains to the place of beginning.
