- 1) relate to the same anchor text originating from multiple websites.

- 3) web links from websites with a [low pagerank or reduced traffic](#).
- 4) links from write-up directory sites or sites that look like hyperlink farms.
- 5) links from link exchanges.
- 6) paid web links (whether in sponsored blog posts, bios, the sidebar or wherever).
- 7) web links from websites with malware cautions.
- 8) web links from websites that aren't in the Google index (hunt for site: YOUR DOMAIN NAME).
- 9) spammy hyperlinks in blog site comments.

### **Take out and also Disavow.**

When you've discovered the web links you want to remove, you have a few choices. Initially, you can request that site owners eliminate the web links that you not really want pointing to your site.

Online search engine Watch has a good tutorial on developing web link extraction requests. It suggests that you send out a respectful request to the on-site get in touch with e-mail and to the WHOIS call (unless they're the exact same) and that you include a link to the web page which has the angering link. This will certainly increase your possibility of getting the web link removed. Attempt a solution like TaskBullet to help conduct your web link elimination project.

An additional alternative is to use a web link extraction tool like these.:
