

PRESIDENT'S COUNCIL FACT SHEET



What is President's Council?

President's Council is an annual giving campaign started in the early 1990s to fund the efforts of the philanthropy department or, foundation as it was known then, for Civitan International.

Where does the money go?

The majority of donations from the President's Council goes to bringing in more non-dues revenue into Civitan through charitable gifts. This includes legacy gifts from wills or estates, grants, sponsorships and other giving campaigns for Civitan. Basically, the money invested in President's Council makes more money for Civitan.

Does any of the President's Council money support the Civitan International Research Center?

Yes, the donations from members outside the United States typically do go to the CIRC directly. But, the bigger picture here is the money raised through the philanthropy department (President's Council, legacy gifts, Coin Box, Fellows, Major Gifts, individual asks, online campaigns, etc.) allows for more money intended for the cause to actually get there through events like the Breakthru Golf tournament, Walk and Roll and Civitans at the Helm. Your investment into the President's Council makes more money for the CIRC in the long run.
